## PAPER

- packaging made of paper, cardboard,
- catalogues, leaflets, brochures
- newspapers and magazines
- school and office paper, printed cards
- notebooks and books
- kraft paper
- bags and paper bags



## GLASS

- bottles and jars for drinks and food
- glass packaging for cosmetics



## BIO

- vegetable and fruit waste
- branches of trees and shrubs
- mowed grass, leaves, flowers
- sawdust and tree bark
- unimpregnated wood
- leftovers of food
